Hengeler advises Deutsche Bahn on Scandlines sale

On 19 June 2007, Deutsche Bahn AG and the Danish Ministry of Transport and Energy, shareholders of Scandlines AG, signed a share sales agreement to sell all shares in Scandlines to a consortium comprising Allianz Capital Partners GmbH, 3i Group and Deutsche Seereederei GmbH. The transaction value amounts to €1.56 bn.
