Hengeler Mueller advises Merrill Lynch on swap agreement with Schaeffler

Schaeffler KG has made a voluntary public tender offer to the shareholders of Continental AG. In this context, Schaeffler announced that the bidder had concluded a swap agreement with Merrill Lynch International, within the scope of which a swap position relative to approx. 28% of Continental shares had been established.

Hengeler Mueller has been advising Merrill Lynch International on this swap agreement.
