Hengeler Mueller represents William Prym in proceedings to reduce EU cartel fine

On 31 March 2011 the European Commission reduced the fine of EUR 40.5 million imposed on William Prym in the cartel proceedings "fasteners" by EUR 25 million. Thereby, the Commission applied its new guidelines from 10 June 2010 on the so-called Inability to Pay Proceedings.
