Hengeler Mueller advises ThyssenKrupp on Stainless Steel Transaction with Outokumpu

On January 31, 2012 ThyssenKrupp announced a transaction combining TK's stainless steel business Inoxum with the Finnish stainless steel producer Outokumpu. In May 2011 ThyssenKrupp had published its intentions to carve out their Stainless Global division and to pursue an IPO, a spin-off or a sale of the division.

Hengeler Mueller advised on the carve out which was completed as of September 30, 2011 and the M&A process as well as the transaction alternatives IPO and spin-off which were prepared in parallel.
